## **How to Pray for One Another**

If you are going to move to another level in your prayer life, then you must learn how to pray for one another. Before we begin let's define some critical words for this lesson.

**Intercession** – *To offer prayer on behalf of another person or group of persons.* 

**Intercessory Prayer** – A prayer that asks God to meet with others and to provide for their need. It's not self-focused, but others focused. It is a call to stand in the gap between a holy God and a person in need.

**Intercessor** – A Christian who prays for another person.
